 - o Brought back All Star Tournaments to Castle Shannon at u8, u10 and u12
 - o Water Line and new sink in Municipal Field concessions
 - o Water Line in Municipal storage room for watering field
 - o Additional power lines for concession at Municipal
 - o Organization of Golf Outing to raise additional funding for the association
 - o Donation of field line and field dry by Castle Shannon borough
 - o Government Grants for Riehl Garage, Sleepy Hollow Batting cage and Scorers booth.
 - o Additional storage area at Municipal field

New Business (Public Comments):

- Vince Smith asked the new board members to take their seats. Dan Collins (President), Bruce Hrivnak (Vice President), Dana Cain (Treasurer), Stephanie McCartney (Secretary), John Philistine (Trustee), and Pat Pierce (Trustee). Equipment Manager position is currently vacant.

Bruce Hrivnak (Vice President) made a motion to appoint Mark Wetmiller as Equipment Manager; Dan Collins seconded the motion; all in favor, motion carries.

- Dan Collins worked with borough to reserve July 1st for annual CSYA Picnic for all sports participated by the membership.
- Bruce Hrivnak announced he is working with the Tribune Review to get a sponsorship donation of \$6000 for baseball and softball for next year.
- Dan Collins is working with the borough manager to get approval for putting sponsorship signs up at Municipal Field. He will have more details in the weeks to come as he is working on a proposal.
- Rick Mazzarini DABA representative for 13yr baseball requested to get a list of all 12yr old players moving to Colt league for next year so they could be contacted. Also asked that CSYA reserve Hamilton field for next year's 13yr old teams (Sat/Sun).
- Rick Mazzarini requested that Hamilton field grass be cut on a more frequent basis and shorter.
- Tim Kickler asked about moving Spring Soccer to Hamilton field with the pending reseeding for Riehl Soccer field in the spring. A long discussion ensued with no decision being made on to move to Hamilton. Dan will work with the borough on getting Riehl done as soon as possible. Need to figure out logistics, resources, equipment storage and concessions.

Dan Collins made a motion to adjourn at 7:43pm; Bruce Hrivnak seconded the motion; all in favor, motion carried. Next meeting will be on Tuesday January 17th at 7:00pm in the CSYA Meeting Room A.
